Roberta to ride on

FOR 61-year-old Roberta Gordon, Mother's Day this year is to be her 51st day on the road as she and her fellow cyclists pedal their way around Australia.

Roberta and 25 other cyclists are to spend Sunday riding from Brisbane to Nambour and be hosted by members of Caboolture Rotary Club for lunch during a stop at Centenary Lakes as part of the Great Australian Bike Ride

The local Rotary club is one of Roberta's sponsors.

In 2006, Roberta completed a 2000km ride to Birdsville and, on this ride, aims to raise \$40,000 for Australian Rotary Health.

The Great Australian Bike Ride began at Mornington, Victoria, on March 21 and is to finish in Melbourne on World Mental Health Day, October 10, after six and a half months and 17,800km.

The ride is organised by Australian Rotary Health, which is an Australian Rotary clubs program to raise awareness of mental illness.
