



Rotarians fund-raise in Aussie bicycle ride

Dalby Rotarians Bernie Caffery and Dick Heiler are set to participate in the largest Australia-wide fund-raising project ever undertaken by Rotary, the Great Australian Bicycle Ride.

Funds raised from the ride will go to the Australian Rotary Health Research Fund, which is one of the largest independent health research funds in Australia.

The two Rotarians are undertaking the Queensland stage of the ride from Brisbane to Townsville from May 10-25.

The ride commenced in Melbourne on March 21 and there are nine stages to the ride which concludes on October 10 in Melbourne.

Bernie and Dick say their reasons for doing the ride are not only to raise money for this worthy cause but also to encourage others to get fit and healthy.

The Rotarians see it as a personal challenge and wish to promote cycling as an excellent sporting and recreational activity for all ages.

Their entry fee is being paid by the Dalby Rotary Club and along
